- has systems in place to work responsibly for the environment



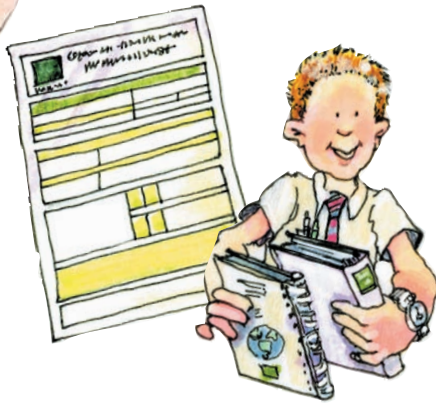
Questions

Obtain and review the environmental approvals of your contractors to make sure they are approved to do the work that you have hired them to do.

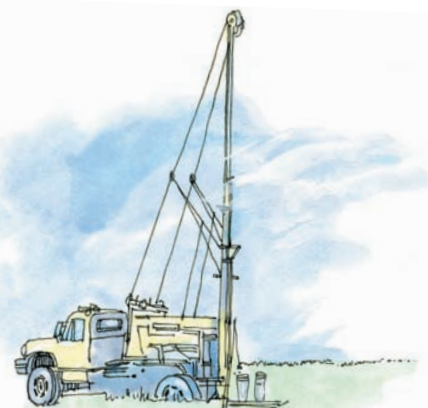
Provide them with a copy of the **EARTH 1st Manual** so they know what is expected of them, to work in a way that supports the environment.
